REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

1. The following changes to all documents in the bid package:

The due date and time for proposals has changed from 5:00 pm June 30, 2014 to 5:00 pm July 10th, 2014.

2. The following changes to the Project Description apply:

Replace the project description with the following:

The project is described as the implementation of safety modifications to east end of the Red Cove Dome Road to include the installation of one 18” culvert 30’ long, 150’ of guardrail, a speed sign, and two warning, steep grade signs. Under this contract, the successful Offeror will be required to:

- i. Attend a pre-construction meeting in Sand Point with the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe and the City of Sand Point to discuss the project scope, schedule, activities, and local hire.
- ii. Provide and mobilize all equipment necessary to perform the safety improvements to the road.
- iii. Demobilize equipment from the site at the completion of the project
- iv. Conform and execute all other Contract requirements
- v. Prepare and submit for approval a progress schedule in accordance with FAR clause 52.236.15
- vi. Prepare work plan and construction details for approval prior to construction activities
- vii. Contract is subject to the prevailing wage requirements in the Davis Bacon Act of March 3, 2931, as amended (46 Stat. 1494) and all laborers and mechanics employed by the Contractor or Subcontractors at any level (excluding federally recognized Indian tribes and tribal organizations) shall be paid wages at not less than those prevailing on similar construction in the locality, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis Beacon Act
