Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Housing Improvement Program (HIP) is a Grant Program to help eligible American Indians /Alaska Natives renovate existing housing or build new homes.

- 1) Housing Improvement Program applications should be on file at the tribal office. Complete the application. Return the completed application, and supporting documentation to the tribal office.
- 2) The tribal office does not send your application to BIA, they keep your completed application, and supporting documentation, on file at the tribal office.
- 3) The tribal office completes a Tribal Annual Performance Report. This contains information for all tribal applicants.
- 4) The tribal office then sends the completed Tribal Annual Performance Report to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Alaska Region, Housing Improvement Program located in Anchorage, Alaska.

You should have the supporting documentation with your completed application.

- Provide a copy of your tribal enrollment card.
- Proof of income for entire household & a signed 1040 form.
- Proof of ownership of land or obtain a 25 yr. lease agreement.
- If you or any family members are claiming disability, you must provide a letter stating disability from a doctor.
