

# The Fall-Winter Registration Hunt for Emperor Geese is Open for the 2018-2019 season



A **Registration Permit** hunt for emperor geese is open in 7 separate hunt areas for the 2018-19 fall-winter season

## **Open to ALASKA RESIDENTS**

### **HUNT AREAS:**

1. Kodiak (GMU 8): **Hunt RO501: Season dates - 8 Oct – 22 Jan**; 175 bird quota; Kodiak Road Area is Closed; Successful hunters have a 24 hour reporting requirement.
2. Aleutians (GMU10, except Unimak Is.): **Hunt RO502: Season dates - 8 Oct – 22 Jan**; 175 bird quota; Successful hunters have a 72 hour reporting requirement.
3. Izembek State Game Refuge (ISGR): **Hunt RO503: Season Dates - 16 Oct – 31 Oct**; 125 bird quota; Successful hunters have a 24 hour reporting requirement.
4. Bristol Bay (GMU 9 except ISGR, GMU 17 and Unimak Is.): **Hunt RO504: Season dates - 1 Sept – 16 Dec**; 150 bird quota; Successful hunters have a 72 hour reporting requirement.
5. Y-K Delta (GMU 18): **Hunt RO505: Season Dates - 1 Sept – 16 Dec**; 125 bird quota; Successful hunters have a 72 hour reporting requirement.
6. Bering Straits (GMU 22): **Hunt RO506: Season dates - 1 Sept – 16 Dec**; 125 bird quota; Successful hunters have 72 hour reporting requirement.
7. Northwest Arctic (GMU 23): **Hunt RO507: Season dates - 1 Sept – 16 Dec**; 125 bird quota; Successful hunters have a 72 hour reporting requirement.

A **FREE** registration permit is required to hunt emperor geese during the 2018-19 season

## **\*\*YOU MUST HAVE A CURRENT HUNTING LICENSE TO GET A REGISTRATION PERMIT\*\***

(check Migratory Game Bird Hunting Regulations for license exemptions and duck stamp requirements)

Each hunt area has its own registration permit which may be obtained at a local licensed vendor, ADF&G offices, or online.

A hunter can harvest and possess only **ONE** emperor goose during the 2018-2019 fall-winter hunting season.

**NEW:** A permit holder may proxy hunt for an eligible individual (contact your local ADF&G office for eligibility requirements and proxy permit information).

**IMPORTANT:** Successful hunters must report their harvest during the required time period to minimize overharvest and possible hunt closures next year.

Hunts will be closed on the last date of the season or by **Emergency Order** when their harvest quotas are met.
