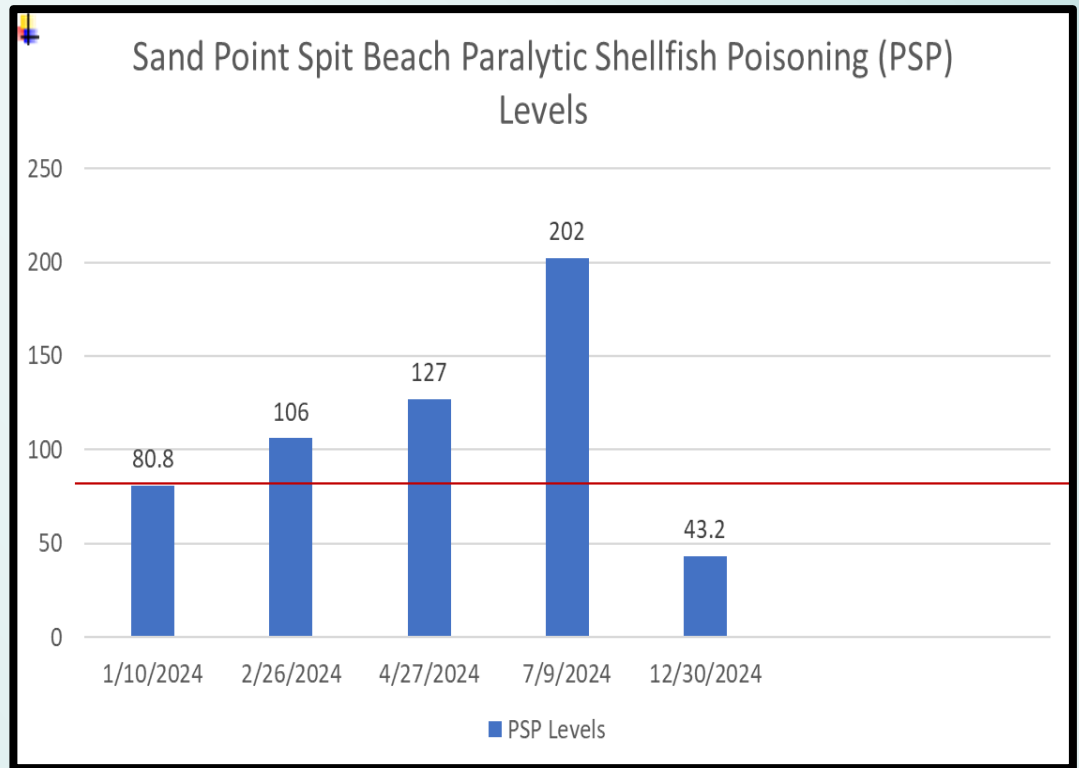




# Sand Point Spit Beach PSP Results

The Response to Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning in Aleut Communities project is funded by the Knik Tribe's harmful algal blooms (HABs) project, Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning Risk Management. Samples are analyzed by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation's Environmental Health Laboratory using approved analytical methods. Data collection will continue as needed and requested by the Knik Tribe.
