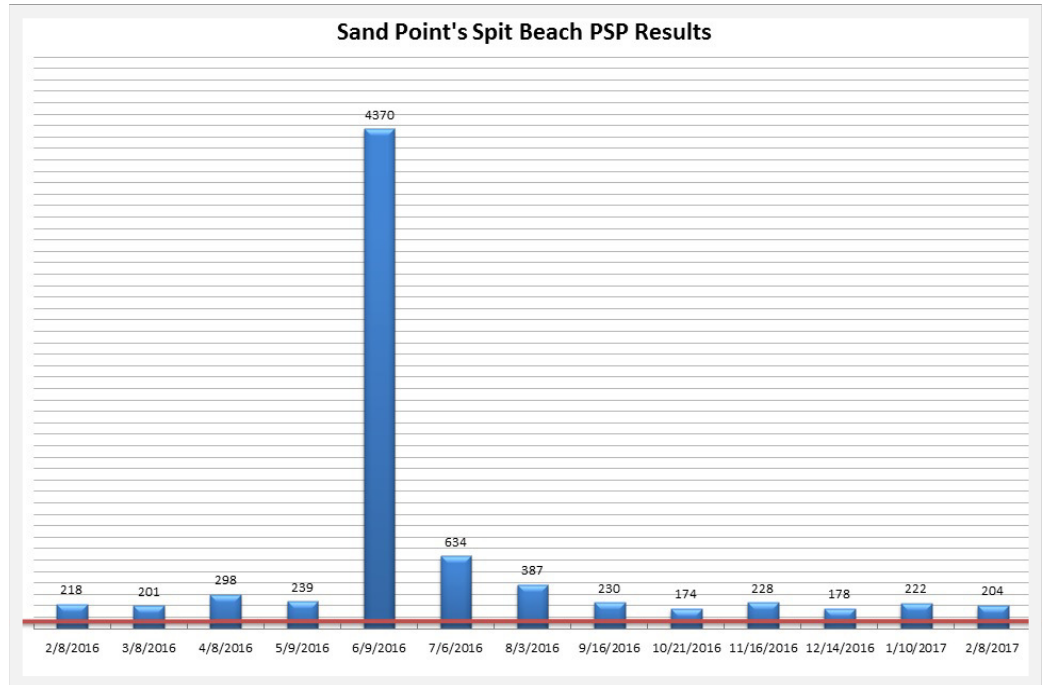


Sand Point Spit Beach PSP Results



The February 8, 2017 clam sample has elevated PSP levels of **204 micrograms** and is ABOVE the FDA limit of 80 micrograms! These are unsafe PSP levels!
