

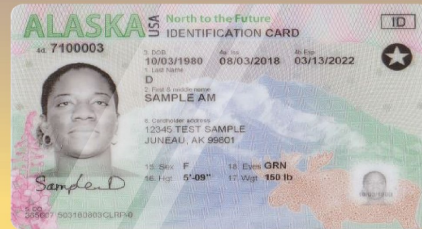

## What is a Real ID?

It's an Alaska driver's license or state ID that meets the highest security standards required by federal law.

Beginning October 1, 2020, Alaska residents will need a Real ID, Passport, Military ID or other federally compliant ID to fly on commercial airlines, visit or work on a military base or other federal property.



The  says your Alaska ID is Real ID compliant.

## Examples of Documents That Can be Used to Obtain a Real ID:

### FOR IDENTITY AND LAWFUL STATUS

Passport, birth certificate, or other identity and lawful status document.

### FOR NAME CHANGES

Marriage certificate, divorce certificate, or other eligible and applicable document.

### FOR SOCIAL SECURITY VERIFICATION

Social Security Card, W-2 or 1099 form, with full SSN.

### FOR ALASKA RESIDENCY VERIFICATION

Two items demonstrating Alaska principal physical residency, one of which was issued within the last 90 days. This can be recent mail, a bank statement, a lease agreement or other eligible proof.

## Is it Mandatory?

No. Your regular Alaska driver's license or state ID will still be valid for other identification purposes, except flying or visiting federal properties.
