RESOLUTION 00-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE AUTHORIZING THE ALEUTIAN PRIBILOF ISLANDS ASSOCIATION, INC. (APIA), TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE "ORAL HISTORY AND DOCUMENTING CULTURAL TRADITIONS" PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT.

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point strongly supports Aleut cultural Heritage preservation efforts; and


WHEREAS, APIA is the Alaska Native regional tribal organization authorized by tribal resolution to contract for and provide certain federal and state programs and services on behalf of tribal members of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand point; and

WHEREAS, APIA currently operates a regional Cultural Heritage Program and has a demonstrated history of administering effective regional programs and services on behalf of tribes and for the benefit of Aleut tribal members; and


WHEREAS, the National Park Service currently has a pending Request for Proposals aimed at funding projects designed to record oral histories and document cultural traditions that are rapidly being lost by the Aleuts of the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Region of Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby authorizes APIA to apply for and if awarded, administer a grant from the U.S. National park Service under the "oral History and Documenting Cultural Traditions" NPS grant funding category.
