**Resolution No. 00-04**

**WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a Federally recognized Tribe for the native village of Sand Point, and**

**WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Government and has authority to work for the best interests of its tribal members, and**

**WHEREAS, David O. Osterback is qualified to represent and speak on behalf of our tribal/organization; and**

**WHEREAS, hunting, fishing and gathering for subsistence purposes is of fundamental interest to Alaska Native and tribal economies, health, cultural survival and spiritual well-being; and**

**WHEREAS, on May 1 - 3, 2000 the Alaska Inter-Tribal Council has invited all Alaska Native tribes and organizations to participate in a statewide gathering, the purpose of which is to review the current Alaska Native policy on subsistence, enable an exchange of information and updates on events affecting subsistence, and reach consensus on any changes to the current Alaska Native subsistence policy; and**

**WHEREAS, David O. Osterback has the necessary knowledge and experience to enable him to articulate the concerns and desires of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe with regard to the issue of subsistence, and to participate in our behalf at the May 2000 AI-TC subsistence meeting.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that David O. Osterback is hereby authorized to be the official delegate of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe to the AI-TC gathering on subsistence that will be held in Anchorage, May 1 - 3, 2000; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the May 2000 subsistence gathering, David O. Osterback is hereby authorized to speak to any and all issues on behalf of our tribal/organization, and to cast a vote on our behalf as a part of the subsistence gathering's processes.**
