WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe has a vested interest in the education of the tribes children, and


WHEREAS, the Aleutians East Borough School District provides a well rounded educational program for our children, including an Indian Education Program through the Johnson O'Malley grant program.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Aleutians East Borough School District to apply for and administer the JOM grant for FY-2001, and



Please find enclosed a copy of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribes resolution 00-09 authorizing the Aleutians East Borough School District to apply for and administer the Johnson O'Malley grant funds on behalf of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe for FY-2001.

The Tribal Council is requesting that the JOM grant funds be used to educate our students in the Aleut language and Aleut culture. It is of utmost importance that our students be provided with the opportunity to learn the Aleut language and the Aleut culture. In accordance with the federal guidelines the Tribal Council is requesting that these skills be incorporated into our school curriculum and the JOM funds be used for this purpose.

In addition the QTT JOM committee members reported to the tribal council that they had not been notified of the JOM committee meetings held last year, so they were unable to attend any of the meetings that may have taken place. The Tribal Council was very concerned about this and would like to request a copy of the minutes for the JOM Committee meeting held last year and would also request the AEBSD provide the Tribal Council with a calendar of the JOM Committee meetings scheduled to be held during this upcoming year. Your assistance on this matter is greatly appreciated.
