**A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE SUPPORTING THE ALEUTIAN/  
PRIBILOF ISLANDS ASSOCIATION, INC. (APIA) IN PERFORMING TRANSPORTATION  
PLANNING AT THE DIRECTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL.**

WHEREAS, The Native Village of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body for the Native village of Sand Point, and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian/ Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. (APIA) is an Alaska Native Regional non-profit organization established to promote overall economic, social, cultural, and environmental needs of the Aleut People; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe would like to develop transportation plans in order to establish future direction for infrastructure development in Sand Point and to ensure that transportation projects are delivered in a coordinated fashion, and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe would also like to develop an up-to-date comprehensive transportation improvement plan which identifies multiple projects and essential information on feasibility study, easement locations, scopes of work, preliminary designs, and cost estimates, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation Appropriations Act for FY-2000 provided \$32,589 funding for Indian Reservation Roads program, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council on July 12, 2000 of funds available in the amount of \$32,589 to the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council and has requested a revised application, scope of work, and budget to be submitted before July 28, 2000, and


WHEREAS, APIA has revised the original application to the Department of Transportation and has made adjustments to it in order to reflect the level of available funding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council hereby request funding be provided to APIA from the BIA to assist the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe complete village-specific IRR transportation planning for Sand Point, Alaska.
