A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT ASSURING  
A COMPREHENSIVE AND COORDINATED EFFORT IN ESTABLISHING THE  
CULTURAL AND MEDIA CENTER AS A PRIORITY

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the duly authorized governing body for the Native Tribe located in Sand Point, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is mandated by its constitution to ensure the general health and welfare of its member families and children; and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has developed and adopted a Long Range Plan in June, 1994 and revised and updated that Plan in February, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Plan identifies the 2001 Work Plan focus for the Council; and

WHEREAS, the 2001 Work Plan ranks the development of a cultural and media center as the top priority for the community; and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is applying to the HUD ICDBG program for funds for the cultural and media center; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council hereby makes the following assurances:

- \* that the cultural and media center is a community-based project identified as a priority for FY2001; and
- \* that the identification process for this prioritization involved the tribal members; and
- \* that community and regional organizations have expressed their support of this project through letter included in this application; and
- \* that this project directly supports the stated mission of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council to "provide for the self-government and quality of life for our membership through social , economic, education, health and cultural services and programs"; and
