WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council's mission is to provide opportunities to enhance the quality of life for its membership through economic and social services and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has adopted a Long Range Plan which addresses the economic and social needs of the community for the next five years; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has successfully obtained funding and is currently constructing a Native Community Building which is a top priority of the Long Range Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Native Community Building will provide urgently needed social and economic benefits to low income Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council needs \$150,000.00 to complete construction for the Building; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council recognizes that its housing needs have changed due to a stabilization of population; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has available through NAHASDA \$150,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal

Council reprioritizes \$150,000.00 of NAHASDA funds available for the completion of the Native Community Building.
