RESOLUTION 01-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE TO APPLY FOR EPA/IGAP FUNDS AND CONTINUE THE COMMUNITY IGAP ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 (October 1, 2001 – September 30, 2002) and 2003 (October 1, 2002 – September 30, 2003)

- WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin (QT) Tribal Council of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized Tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and,
- WHEREAS, the QT Tribal Council consists of an active seven-member governing body of the QT Tribe of Sand Point; and,
- WHEREAS, the QT Tribal Council has the right to contract for and provide certain Federal and State programs and services on behalf of tribal members of the Native Community of Sand Point; and,
- WHEREAS, the QT Tribal Council recognizes the importance of a Solid Waste Management Plan; maintaining safe drinking water; sanitary sewage and waste disposal; cancer-related illnesses and deaths of community members; hazardous waste handling and disposal and, other objectives as determined by the Sand Point Tribal Council, and Environmental Council working in conjunction with the IGAP Coordinator; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribe continues to promote the development of local capacities to effectively address environmental concerns with the IGAP Grant; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribe shall be represented by the Environmental Coordinator regarding environmental issues, needs, and services under direction of the Sand Point Tribal and Environmental Councils; and,
- WHEREAS, the second-year IGAP Grant will continue to provide an effective public outreach campaign of environmental programs and issues to Tribal Council, Environmental Council, and Community Members of Sand Point with recommended plan of action (s); and continued development of the tribal environmental policies,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THE **Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council** hereby authorizes the application of IGAP Grant funding for fiscal year 2002 and 2003 from the Environmental Protection Agency to continue funding in the second and third program years of the Sand Point Community Environmental Project.
