A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE URBAN RURAL YOUTH PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a federally recognized tribe authorized with government to government status with the United States of America; and,
- WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe authorized by its constitution to act on behalf of the native tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS, We, as people, who are interested in our youth, whether they are in the rural or urban communities, will advocate and support their growth and involvement; and,
- WHEREAS, Whereas, Senator Ted Stevens has appropriated funds to the U.S. Department of Education to administer a grant to the Alaska Humanities Forum and its partner, the Alaska Native Heritage Center, to develop and implement the "Urban Rural Youth Program; and,
- WHEREAS, Our Tribal Council will support this project called "Urban Rural Youth Program" and will help in achieving its goal to promote a statewide sense of Community through cultural awareness and respect for diversity by bringing young people together to experience each other's culture and way of life, in a positive and successful manner that our ancestors have always done.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council will support the Urban Rural Youth Program in making sure that the visiting urban students will be safe and given an opportunity to learn about and appreciate our culture and way of life.
