**RESOLUTION #02-15**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT SUPPORTING PARTICIPATION IN EXPLORING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BULK FUEL TANK FARM IN SAND POINT.**

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe authorized with government to government status with the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe authorized by its Constitution to act on behalf of the Native tribal members; and,

WHEREAS, the high cost of fuel negatively impacts the standard of living of all residents of the community of Sand Point; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sand Point, the Shumagin Corporation, and the federally recognized sovereign tribes of Qagan Tayagungin, Pauloff Harbor and Unga, are organizations formed by and representing the people of Sand Point, tribal members and corporation shareholders; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe considers exploring the establishment of a Bulk Fuel Farm in Sand Point potentially beneficial to the economic development and well-being of the community; and,

WHEREAS, upon all parties receiving approval from it's respective Board or Council to proceed, then all participating entities would work together to develop the necessary requirements to establish the feasibility of the project; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe expresses its support for working with all the above mentioned entities in exploring the feasibility of establishing a Bulk Fuel Tank Farm in Sand Point.

Passed and adopted by a duly constituted quorum of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2002.
