RESOLUTION No. 02-20

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ADDITION OF ROADS TO THE BIA SYSTEM.

- WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point (hereinafter "Tribe") is a federally recognized tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe qualifies for services and benefits under both the Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) and IRR Road Maintenance programs; and
- WHEREAS, the BIA is responsible for updating the IRR Inventory and Transportation Improvement Plan when a tribe determines there is a need for a BIA system change; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is developing a 20 year transportation plan to be included as part of the Alaska Region's 20 year transportation plan and Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified a need to update and create mileage in the BIA system for the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified routes that qualify as Indian Reservation Roads; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified IRR routes that are vital to its economic development as part of its 20 year transportation plan and TIP; and
- WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Tribe that the BIA acquire the right-of-way for these routes on behalf of the Tribe;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Council finds that the route identified on the attached Alaska Region Transportation Plan Update, dated September 23, 2002 is an IRR route vital to the economic development of the tribe and the well-being of its members and have been identified as such through the Tribe's 20 year transportation plan and Transportation Improvement Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Council hereby request the BIA to add the route identified in the attached Alaska Region Transportation Plan Update, dated September 23, 2002 to the BIA's Inventory of Indian Reservation Roads as BIA system routes for construction and maintenance.
