A resolution of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe to support Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. applying for a Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Administration for Native Americans, Social and Economic Development grant for the purpose of improving local tribal capacity, supporting tribal economic development and developing an interactive electronic job bank in the tribal communities of the Eastern Aleutians.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council of Sand Point, Alaska is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government-to-government status with in the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council consists of an active 7-member governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin tribe of Sand Point, Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has the right to contract for and provide certain Federal and State programs and services on behalf of tribal members of the Native Community of Sand Point; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a Consortia member of the Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. for the primary purpose of improving the health of all of the people of the Eastern Aleutians; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe continues to promote the development of local capacities to effectively support Tribal economic development and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe endeavors to provide effective Tribal Member continuing education, training, job placement outreach and programming to address economic development issues identified by the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council, and Community of Sand Point in conjunction with other community supporting agencies, including Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council, and Community of Sand Point in conjunction with other community supporting agencies, including Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. have used identified issues to recommend a plan(s) of action and will continue to reevaluate and develop Tribal Job Bank Programming; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has reviewed and encourages the proposal for an Administration for Native Americans, Social and Economic Develop Grant applied for by Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. for the purpose of improving Economic Development Programming through improving and developing an interactive job bank systems in the Eastern Aleutians; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council will provide in-kind administration services by working with Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. to continue to develop the priorities of Tribal Economic Development Programming and the community preferred forms of job bank systems, including identifying elders and other possible volunteers to contribute to the development of community identified Tribal Economic Development Programming goals; and.

Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. (EAT) is starting the current cycle of grant proposal development. Within our Tribal Programs Department, we are actively seeking new funding support for a grant for the Administration of Native American Grant Proposal for the purpose of funding a region wide interactive electronic job bank, in the communities of the Eastern Aleutian Tribes, Inc. service area and Anchorage.

This proposal includes a request for funding to design, develop and build an online job bank database for the Aleutians East Borough Region that employers can advertise job openings; potential employees can research jobs; as well as, utilize other online job search resources. It will include request to providing funding for recruiting employers to use the online Job Bank to advertise job openings within the region. Proposals are also being developed for the purpose of selling advertising to businesses within the region and setting up a minimal fee schedule for advertisements. Additional funds are being sought to further recruit potential employees thru assistance in resume building, application resources as well as mock interview questions for potential employees to review.
