In support of forming a task force to study and implement therapeutic courts in the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Region and to seek funding

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ALEUTIAN PRIBILOF ISLANDS ASSOCIATION, INC. (APIA), APPLICATION FOR A US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE GRANT FOR TRIBAL THERAPEUTIC COURT ASSISTANCE).

WHEREAS, the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. (APIA) is a regional non-profit tribal organization with members consisting of the thirteen (13) federally recognized tribes of the Aleutian Chain and Pribilof Islands region of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, A/PIA exists to promote the overall economic, social, cultural, health and environmental needs of the Aleut People; and

WHEREAS, alcohol and drug abuse affects all aspects of the justice system, from child protection proceedings to criminal conduct and juvenile justice; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of tribal members and their families to resolve alcohol related justice issues locally and within the tribe, if possible

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN Tribal Council supports APIA in their efforts to pursue grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice to study and assist tribes in the Aleutian and Pribilof Islands Region to establish tribal therapeutic courts, and

FURTHERMORE BE IT RESOLVED, that QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN Tribal Council states that the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association is its authorized representative for the purposes of applying for the aforementioned grant.
