A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ALEUTIAN/PRIBILOF ISLAND ASSOCIATION, INC. (APIA), TO APPLY FOR INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING INJURY PREVENTION PROGRAMS IN THE COMMUNITIES OF THE ALEUTIAN/PRIBILOF SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a federally recognized tribe in the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands region of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, APIA is regional tribal organization authorized by tribal resolution to contract for and provide certain federal and state programs and services on behalf of tribal members of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point recognizes the importance of the implementation of an Injury Prevention Program for the general health and welfare of the people of Sand Point;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby authorizes APIA to apply for funding from the Indian Health Service (IHS) for the purpose of implementing an Injury Prevention Program.
