**WHEREAS**, the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. has been designated by the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point as the Tribal Representative to represent the tribe's best interest in the Child in Need of Aid cases involving tribal members; and a completed application for enrollment and supporting documents have been provided to the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point and the Tribe has no reason to deny enrollment.


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Shawn M. Pletnikoff is an enrolled member of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point.
