RESOLUTION 07-01

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government-to-government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council consists of an active seven-member governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has the right to contract for and provide certain Federal and State programs and services on behalf of tribal members of the Native Community of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian Housing Authority Crime Prevention Program (CPP) is designed to allow tribes to develop and implement programs that provide opportunities to address crime prevention or other related activities aimed at NAHASDA eligible youth, to promote healthier and safer lifestyles; and

WHEREAS, AHA will match up to a maximum of \$3000, with a \$3000 commitment from the tribal participant, giving the tribe a maximum total program budget of \$6000; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe will use these funds to go towards the Boys and Girls Club in Sand Point and to the Tribe's annual Culture Camp; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby requests the authority to utilize these Crime Prevention Program funds to continue both the Boys and Girls Club program and the Tribe's annual Culture Camp.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY A DULY CONSTITUTED QUORUM OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE ON THIS 4TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2007, WITH A VOTE OF 4 FOR, 0 AGAINST, AND 0 ABSTENTIONS.
