WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point and APIAI have a common focus for the Unangan people: to promote self-sufficiency, independence, and unity of our people; assist in community based health, safety, and well-being of our communities; and to strengthen and preserve our cultural heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point has successfully partnered with APIAI for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, our people have lived in our village for thousands of years and we would like to continue to do so; and

WHEREAS, energy costs are currently increasing thus increasing the cost of living in our village; and

WHEREAS, if we find methods of saving energy, the cost of living in our village will decrease, thereby diminishing the number of people moving from our community; and

WHEREAS, our people desire to be provided with sustainable, reliable, affordable energy; and


WHEREAS, our community will have economic development opportunities with the renewable energy improvements; and
