**RESOLUTION 11-05**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS (BIA) AND THE STATE OF ALASKA TO DEVELOP A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) TO FACILITATE USE OF INDIAN RESERVATION ROAD HIGH PRIORITY PROJECT (IRRHPP) FUNDS TO PAVE THE SCHOOL LOOP ROAD.**

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point applied to BIA for and was awarded \$1 million for the IRRHPP to pave the School Loop Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sand Point obtained complete funding from the State of Alaska for the paving of the School Loop Road and the project is now under the control of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe can no longer directly utilize the HPP funds for the intended purpose as applied for and required by BIA; and

WHEREAS, the BIA and the State of Alaska have presented a plan to develop a MOU whereby BIA would work directly with the State of Alaska who would administer funding and utilize it for the paving of the School Loop Road, freeing up the other funding from the State of Alaska to work on other roads in Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe desires that the HPP funds are used to benefit the community; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe agrees to the BIA and State of Alaska developing a MOU to facilitate use of the HPP funds to go towards the paving of the School Loop Road Project.

**I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE ABOVE RESOLUTION WAS DULY ADOPTED BY THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE AT A MEETING HELD ON 13 DAY OF MARCH, 2011, BY A QUORUM OF 6 YES, AND 0 NO, 0 ABSTAINING, AND 1 NOT VOTING.**
