RESOLUTION 11-08

IN THE MATTER OF DOMINIC ALLEN MUESE (MINOR CHILD) WHOSE DATE OF BIRTH IS NOVEMBER 7, 2003. THIS CHILD IS ELIGIBLE FOR ENROLLMENT WITH THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is the "child's tribe" pursuant to the Indian Child Welfare Act, 25 U.S.C 1930(5); and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association, Inc., has been designated by the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point as the Tribal representative to represent the tribe's best interest in this Child in Need of Aid case; and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association, Inc., has identified the home of Talia Italia Iloilo & Tufi Iloilo, which does meet the needs of Dominic Allen Muese and provide permanency, continuity and stability; and

WHEREAS, this consent is specifically given to the adoptive parents, Talia Italia Iloilo & Tufi Iloilo; and

WHEREAS, Laray June Gundersen retains the right to the following: to receive twice yearly updates about Dominic Allen Muese from the adoptive parents, to send a receive cards and letters involving Dominic Allen Muese, and post adoptive contact with Dominic Allen Muese to be arranged in advance with the adoptive parents at their discretion based on the best interest of the child.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant of 25 U.S.C. 1915 (c), the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby establishes by resolution the first order of preference under the Indian Child Welfare Act for Talia Italia Iloilo & Tufi Iloilo to become the adoptive parents of Dominic Allen Muese.

I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE ABOVE RESOLUTION WAS DULY ADOPTED BY THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE AT A MEETING HELD ON 26 DAY OF MAY, 2011, BY A QUORUM OF 5 YES, AND 0 NO, 0 ABSTAINING, AND 0 NOT VOTING.
