RESOLUTION 12-05

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APIA'S ENVIRONMENTAL AND PEER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point receives or has applied for a GAP grant from EPA to focus on capacity building to establish and manage a tribal environmental protection program on behalf of tribal members of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point recognizes the need and importance of the EPA Peer Assistance Program to provide support and assistance in office and grant administration to GAP grantee tribes in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, APIA has an established environmental program that provides technical assistance to The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point and the communities in the Aleut Region; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point understands that all available GAP funds are earmarked for GAP Programs, tribes receive first priority for funding, consortiums, like APIA, receive second priority funding, and special projects receive third priority funding; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point has not applied for any special projects for FY13 and therefore is not in competition with APIA for FY13 GAP funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby supports the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association to apply for funding from the

Environmental Protection Agency to continue funding the EPA Peer Assistance Network Program and the EPA GAP Technical Assistance to be able to continue to provide assistance to the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe and other Aleutian Pribilof tribes throughout the FY 2013 grant period.


