**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ANTHC'S INDIAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
BLOCK GRANT – IMMINENT THREAT COVID-19 GRANT APPLICATION FROM  
THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is fully authorized to act on behalf of the Tribal members residing in the City of Sand Point in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. Seq (hereby the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, The City of Sand Point is established as a municipal government and primary operator of the City's water treatment plant, which stands to benefit from the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) is a statewide tribal health consortium; and

WHEREAS, The ANTHC will be the primary contractor, responsible for project management; and

WHEREAS, These facilities are managed by the City of Sand Point to provide clean water to and for the benefit of Tribal members and residents of the City of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe and the City of Sand Point recognize that this project will benefit the community and all residents there within by improving access to clean water, sanitation, and other service necessary for maintaining the health and wellbeing of the whole community; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is soliciting applications to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus, for emergencies that constitute imminent threats to health and safety; and


WHEREAS, The City of Sand Point and the ANTHC are committed to preventing, preparing for, and responding to the spread of COVID-19; and
