

**QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN
TRIBAL COUNCIL**

RESOLUTION 93-01

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, P.O. 92-203, and is federally recognized by the United States Government, through the Secretary of the Interior, to receive programs to services provided by the Indian Health Services.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is authorized under Public Law 93-638 to request the Indian Health Service enter into a contract with the Eastern Aleutian Tribe, Inc., a non-profit tribal organization, to conduct any and all health care currently being provided or funded by Indian Health Services and any additional health care services that the organization can provide. The Eastern Aleutian Tribe, Inc. may delegate this authority to a contractor.

The effective date of this resolution shall be concurrent with Eastern Aleutian Tribe, Inc. 638 proposal submission. This proposal will include a transitions plan that will ensure uninterrupted health care.

Once this resolution goes into effect it will be effective until withdrawn.
