

RESOLUTION NO. 93-05

Resolution for Qagan Tayagungin Tribe

Subject: Permission for the Aleutian/Pribilof Island Association, Inc., to contract from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide Employment Assistance, Tribal Operations, Higher Education and Social Services to the Community of Sand Point.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is an Alaska Native village traditionally organize and recognized by the United States through the Secretary of Interior to receive programs and services provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council is the governing body for the Sand Point Natives; and

WHEREAS, Under Public Law 93-638 (Indian Self-Determination and Education assistance Act) the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is authorized to request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into contracts/grants for the following programs:

Tribal Operations
Employment Assistance(Direct Employment & Adult Vocational Training)
Higher Education
Social Services

for services benefitting Alaska Natives at Sand Point.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is interested in the education, training and welfare of the children and adults in Sand Point.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into contract/grant agreements with the Aleutian/Pribilof Island Association, Inc., to conduct the above named programs to provide services in and for the Community of Sand Point for Fiscal Year 1994.
