

RESOLUTION NO. 94-004

INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT (ICWA)


WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is recognized by the Bureau of India Affairs to contract for federal funding; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a federally recognized tribe which has the authority to act on behalf of the native tribal members of the community for Indian Child Welfare (ICWA) cases; and,


WHEREAS, the existing cases are presently in critical need of professional assistance and the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc.'s Community Services Department has maintained a simulation in the delivery of ICWA; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point directs the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. (A/PIA) to submit a proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs/Division of Social Services to seek continued funding for the Indian Child Welfare Act Grant for fiscal year 1994, and be it further resolved that the A/PIA be named lead agency for the grant. This resolution will remain in effect for the duration of the program or until the resolution expires or is rescinded.
