INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE  
TRIBAL MANAGEMENT GRANTS REQUEST

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin is an Alaska Native village traditionally organized and recognized by the United States through the Secretary of Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council is the governing body for the Sand Point Natives; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council is committed to enhancing the quality of life, including health care, of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council has adopted a mission and goals which speak to promoting quality health care for its members; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council wishes to determine the current quality of health care provided, assess health care needs and develop long range health care strategies; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council lacks the financial and personnel resources needed to pursue such a project; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, Tribal Management Grant Program is a source of support and financial assistance to the Qagan Tayagungin Council for such a project; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Council asks, by way of proposal that is being submitted to the Indian Health Service Tribal Management Grant Program, for federal assistance to achieve its goal of caring for the health and well-being of its members.
