
## RESOLUTION #94-006

- WHEREAS,** the tribal government of Sand Point is recognized by the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs as a tribe; and,
- WHEREAS,** the tribal council is concerned about lead (Pb) as a substance which has increasingly been recognized as a health risk to all people especially to our children; and,
- WHEREAS,** the tribal council understands the importance of all tribes in the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Region coordinating efforts to eradicate paint that contains lead from all contaminated homes in our community; and,
- WHEREAS,** the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council recognizes the value of individual tribes working cooperatively with a tribal consortium so that all tribes, Environmental Protection Agency, and the Aleutian/Pribilof Island Association, Inc. will maintain consistent standards in all EPA authorized programs; and,
- WHEREAS,** the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council wants a more effective and cost-efficient approach for tribes wishing to establish such programs; and,
- WHEREAS,** the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. has been recognized as a tribe by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to manage environmental protection programs under the General Assistance Grant;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council asks for the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc.'s Executive Director, on its behalf, to pursue grant funds from the United States Environmental Protection Agency Region 10 for the eradication of all lead containing paints from homes in the community of Sand Point.
