WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin is an Alaska Native village traditionally organized and recognized by the United States through the Secretary of Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council is the governing body for the Sand Point Natives; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council adopted its goals on January 17, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Council determined that the most pressing needs are to develop and strengthen the Council's infrastructure and to prepare a land management and long-range community economic development plan; and

WHEREAS, only minimal resources are available to the Qagan Tayagungin Council to pursue our goals; and

WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans is a source of support and financial assistance to the Qagan Tayagungin Council to help us achieve our goals;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Council asks, by way of proposal that is being submitted to the Administration for Native Americans, for federal assistance in achieving its goals of governance, economic and social improvement.
