SUBJECT: STATE WATERS COD FISHING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe, (Qagan Tayagungin meaning "Eastern People") a federally recognized tribe, in Sand Point Alaska is purely consistent to fishing as a way of life and,

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska opened a State Waters Ground fish Pot, Mechanical Jig, and Hand-Trolled Gurdy Cod Fishery Program around Kodiak Island; and,

WHEREAS, there have been more than 70,000 pounds of the two million pound quota delivered; and,

WHEREAS, this fishery opens a new small boat fishing opportunity for Alaskan fishermen, which directly affects the "Eastern Fishermen" and,

WHEREAS, this fishery helps bridge economical development among coastal communities that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe supports,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point urges the State of Alaska to continue expansion the State Waters Cod Fishery on a enduring basis,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe is in total support of the new small boat fishing opportunity the State of Alaska offers which directly links the Eastern Fisherman to the fishery so they can participate and be involved in the State Waters Cod Fishing Program.
