RESOLUTION 96 - 15

Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point
SUBJECT: ADAK CLOSURE

WHEREAS, the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE as a federally recognized Tribe has broad governmental powers and authorities under federal law; and

WHEREAS, the Adak Military Installation resides within the historic and traditional lands of the Aleut people; and

WHEREAS, the Adak Military Installation may be closed in the near future by the U. S. Government, severely impacting the Aleut communities within the Aleut Region both socially and economically; and

WHEREAS, the ALEUT CORPORATION is the regional ANSCA Corporation for all Aleut communities within the region, and is capable of representing the local communities during proceedings related to the closure and reuse of the Adak Military Installation in such a way as to preserve and protect the rights and interests of all Natives living in the Aleut Region who are impacted by the closure and reuse of the Adak Military Installation; and

WHEREAS, the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE has the authority and power to enter into a joint powers agreement with the other Aleut Tribal Governments within the Aleut Region to form a consortium of Tribal Governments to plan for the reuse, acquisition and operation of the real property, buildings, facilities, equipment, and personal property of the Adak Military Installation; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE hereby authorizes the ALEUT CORPORATION to represent the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE as its agent in regards to all proceedings relating to the closure and reuse of the military installation at Adak; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE hereby authorizes the ALEUT CORPORATION to investigate Title 1, P. L. 93-638 contracting, the Tribal Government Tax Status Act, the Indian Finance Act, the Indian Reorganization Act, and other applicable federal legislation and regulations to identify opportunities associated with the reuse of the military installation at Adak on its behalf and the behalf of the Tribal Governments of the Aleut Region; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE authorizes the ALEUT CORPORATION to assist the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE and the Tribal Governments of the Aleut Region in the preparation of a joint powers agreement to form a consortium of ALEUT TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS to be known as the UNITED ALEUT NATION to plan for the reuse, acquisition, and operation of the ADAK MILITARY INSTALLATION; and


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE requires the ALEUT CORPORATION to inform the TRIBE of closure and reuse proceedings and opportunities on a monthly basis for as long as this Resolution is in effect.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 21st day of December 1995 at Sand Point Alaska where a duly constituted quorum was present.
