RESOLUTION 96 - 19 Joint Powers Agreement

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a sovereign federally recognized Tribe enjoying a government to government relationship with the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe as a federally recognized Tribe has broad government powers and authorities under federal law; and,

WHEREAS, the Adak Naval Base resides within the historic and traditional lands of the Aleut people; and,

WHEREAS, the Adak Naval Base will be closed in the near future by the U.S. Government, severely impacting socially, culturally, and economically the Aleut communities within the Aleut Region; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe has the authority and power to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with the other Aleut Tribal Governments within the Aleut Region to form a consortium of Tribal Governments to plan for reuse, to acquire and to operate the land, real property, buildings, facilities, equipment, and personal property of the Adak Naval base; and,

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe has the authority and power to enter into a United Aleut Nation with the other Aleut Tribal Governments within the Aleut Region to form a consortium of Tribal Governments to represent the Aleut people and their rights to the land and sea resources of the regions; and,

WHEREAS, the United Aleut Nation, the regional consortium in the form of a special purpose unit of government formed under a joint powers agreement, is capable of representing the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe during proceedings related to the closure and reuse of the Adak Naval Base in such a way as to preserve and protect the rights and interests of all Natives living in the Aleut Region and impacted by the closure and reuse of the Adak Naval base; and,

WHEREAS, the United Aleut Nation, the regional consortium in the form of a special purpose unit of government formed under a joint powers agreement, is capable of representing the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe to represent the Aleut people and their governments to secure and protect their rights to the land and sea resources of the region; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of the Tribal Governments and Traditional Councils of the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Region and authorizes the United Aleut Nation or its designee to represent the

Qagan Tayagungin Tribe by granting all the powers and authorities set forth in the Joint Powers Agreement in regards to all proceedings relating to the closure and reuse of the military installation at Adak and to secure and protect the rights of the Aleut people to the land and sea resources of the region; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council appoints Loretta Stroud at P.O. Box 37, Sand Point, AK 99661, (907) 383-5616 phone, (907) 383-5814 fax, as Commissioner to act on behalf of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe with all the powers and authorities granted to the United Aleut Nation; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council appoints Arleen M. Gardner at P.O. Box 81, Sand Point, AK 99661 (907) 383-5616 phone (907)383-5814 fax, as Alternate Commissioner with all the powers and authorities granted to the United Aleut Nation and to act on behalf of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe only in the absence of the Commissioner.
