THE STATE OF ALASKA MANAGEMENT OF SUBSISTENCE
HUNTING AND FISHING
SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska contains a diverse population with very cultural related needs;
and

WHEREAS, each culture has created a lifestyle dependent upon the availability of fish and game
within it's area; and

WHEREAS, no culture in the State of Alaska has similar subsistence needs geographically; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska knows and understands the needs for the various cultures; and

WHEREAS, US Government intervention to resolve the cultural lifestyle needs will not provide
area by area recognition; and

WHEREAS, the need for a fair and equitable resolution can be made without Federal
intervention.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe supports the State of
Alaska's management of subsistence for the entire State,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe encourages the Legislature
and Governor Knowles to compromise and bring the subsistence issue to a vote of all Alaskan
residents.
