A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALEUTIAN PRIBILOF ISLANDS ASSOCIATION, INC. TO CONTRACT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is the Tribal Governing Body for the the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal members; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need to assist tribal families with child care and financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Family Support Administration Child Care and Development Block Grant is specifically focused on the assistance with child care to eligible American Indian and Alaska Native peoples; and,

WHEREAS, the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association ,Inc. is a Native Non-Profit Corporation representing the native community in the A/PIA Region to provide health, welfare and education programs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby requests the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to enter into contract/ grant agreement with the Aleutian Pribilof Islands Association ,Inc. To provide the above named program continuously until this resolution is withdrawn by the tribal governing body.
