RESOLUTION 97-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE BIA RED COVE PROJECT AS THE NATIVE VILLAGE OF SAND POINT PRIORITY ISTEAL PROJECT.

WHEREAS: The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS: The BIA Red Cove Road Project is the Number One transportation priority identified for the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point, and

WHEREAS: There is presently no road providing access to the new landfill site, and the need for the new landfill access road remains acute; and


WHEREAS: The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe finds the BIA Red Cove Road Project is the Native Village of Sand Point's most immediate transportation need eligible for IRR/ISTEA funding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council for the Native Village of Sand Point, hereby affirms and establishes the BIA Red Cove Road Project as its Number One priority for ISTEAL funds and requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs proceed with development of the project.
