A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT APPOINTING THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE PRIMARY AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON THE ALEUTIANS EAST BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT'S INDIAN EDUCATION/ JOHNSON O'MALLEY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS; The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS; The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point authorized by its constitution to act on behalf of it tribal members, and

WHEREAS; The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council has a vested interest in the education of the tribes children in the Sand Point School, and

WHEREAS; The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal has authorized the AEBSD to apply for and administer the JOM funding on behalf of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe, and

WHEREAS; 25 CFR requires the establishment of a Indian Education Committee composed of a majority of Indians, tribal governing bodies, of Indian tribes for the purpose of planning, development, implementation, and evaluation of the JOM program, and

WHEREAS; The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council desires to appoint its Representative and alternate to serve on the AEBSD Indian Education Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point hereby appoints Edith I Jacobsen, Tribal Member as QTT's Indian Education/ Johnson O'Malley Committee Representative and Connie K. Kochuten, Tribal Member as the Alternate representative for the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe.
