RESOLUTION 98-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL TO INITIATE CHANGE IN THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS BRIDGE INVENTORY.

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe is a Federally recognized tribe for the native village of Sand Point, and

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe and has the authority to work for the best interest of its members, and

WHEREAS, There is a need to establish an inventory of Bridge for the purpose of creating bridge construction needs data for our people, and

WHEREAS, There is a Federal Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) programs under which eligible Tribes may be provided Bridge construction projects to help meet their transportation need by making an application t the Bureau of Indian Affairs that is initiated by a Tribal resolution, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Council, hereby authorizes our designated Tribal administrator to act as our representative to provide documentation for the purpose of initiating Bridge Inventory changes that meet with our transportation needs and establish our bridge construction needs for projects authorized under the Indian Reservation Roads program and funded by its enabling legislation from the Federal Highway Trust Fund.

The following Bridge projects are listed by priority by name, bridge length, width, type, and crossing.

1. Sand Point Pedestrian Foot Bridge, 255', 6' Timber & Steel Bridge Humboldt Slough crossing.
2. Sand Point Road Bridge, 90', 36', Timber & Steel Bridge, Humboldt Slough crossing.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY A QUORUM OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL THIS 25TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1998. Vote: 5 in favor; 0 opposed; 0 abstained.
