RESOLUTION 99-02

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is interested in traditional knowledge of subsistence practices of all people living in the community of Sand Point; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council understands the importance of all tribes in the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Region coordinating efforts to have valuable information; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point recognizes the value of such information so it can be preserved for future generations and used for future resource cooperation management practices; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point wants a more active role in resource management practices; and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc. is the tribal governing body of the Aleut people under the Indian Self-Determination Act; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point asks for the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc's Executive Director, on its behalf, to pursue grant funds from the National Park Service to assist the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point to develop an oral history project on collecting the traditional knowledge of subsistence practices from our elders, and other users of the resources.
