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RESOLUTION 99-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT SUPPORTING THE ALEUTIAN PRIBILOF ISLANDS ASSOCIATION, INC. (A/PIA) TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS (ANA) TO ASSIST THE TRIBE IN DEVELOPING SUBSISTENCE FOODS PROTECTION PLANS.

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point, and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is interested in evaluating the local environmental information on the community of Sand Point, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands the importance of all tribes in the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Region coordinating efforts to have a healthy environment, and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point recognizes the value of such information so it can be used to develop local subsistence foods protection plans to preserve and maintain the natural resources for future generations, and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point desires a more active role in their own subsistence foods protection planning, and

WHEREAS, the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association is the regional non-profit tribal body of the Aleut people under the Indian Self-Determination Act.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council asks the Aleutian/Pribilof Islands Association, Inc's President/CEO, on its behalf, to pursue grant funds from the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) to assist the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point evaluate their local environmental information and develop a Subsistence Foods Protection Plan to protect and maintain the subsistence resources of the village and Region.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY A DULY CONSTITUTED QUORUM OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF MARCH, 1999. VOTE: 4 in favor; 0 opposed; 0 abstained.
