**A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE OF SAND POINT
SUBMITTING A REQUEST FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE NATIVE AMERICAN FISH &
WILDLIFE SOCIETY.**

WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point, Alaska is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe desires to promote the protection and preservation of its fish and wildlife resources through proper management for the use of its members and future generations, and

WHEREAS, the Native American Fish & Wildlife Society (NAFWS) has been in existence since 1983 and has an established national office to assist the tribes in:

1. Establishing new fish & wildlife programs;
2. Supporting funding for tribal fish & wildlife programs;
3. Educating and training Indian fish & wildlife biologists, managers, technicians & conservation officers.
4. Representing future tribal fish & wildlife needs through the Congressional process
5. Promoting tribal management capabilities on a national level through an exchange of information via newsletters, technical bulletins, other pertinent information as well as regional training/workshops.

WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe fully supports the efforts and activities of the Native American Fish & Wildlife Society as stated above and in the Society's Articles of Incorporation; and

WHEREAS, in order to benefit from the above-listed services, a membership in the NAFWS is required.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council hereby wishes to become a member of the Native American Fish & Wildlife Society and to participate in the services provided by the organization and its staff, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this Resolution of Support be submitted to the NAFWS and be it further,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe supports the efforts of the NAFWS to secure funding to maintain the organization and the services that will be provided directly to tribal fish and wildlife programs.
