**RESOLUTION 99-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBE WITHDRAWING RESOLUTION 96-19 CONCERNING THE JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT AND MEMBERSHIP WITH THE UNITED ALEUT NATION.**


- WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point is a sovereign federally recognized tribe with government to government status with the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council is the governing body of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe of Sand Point, and
- WHEREAS, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe previously enacted Resolution 96-19 authorizing membership in the United Aleut Nation and ratifying the Joint Powers Agreement in regards to all proceedings relating to the closure and reuse of the military installation at Adak, and
- WHEREAS, the United Aleut Nation was formed for the primary purpose of developing a plan for the reuse, to acquire and to operate the land, real property, buildings, facilities, equipment, and personal property of the Adak Naval Base, and
- WHEREAS, the United Aleut Nation has fulfilled the original intent of the Joint Powers Agreement concerning the acquisition of the Adak Naval Base, and
- WHEREAS, The United Aleut Nation has broadened its political involvement and activities beyond the original intent of the Joint Powers Agreement as agreed to by the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, The actions of the United Aleut Nation has caused confusion, conflict and competition between itself, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe, and other regional Aleut organization s which has generated unnecessary political turmoil and damaged the credibility of the region as a whole with certain federal agencies, and
- WHEREAS, The Qagan Tayagungin Tribe desires to withdraw Resolution 96-19 with the United Aleut Nation in hopes of clarifying any misunderstanding in the powers delegated in the Joint Powers Agreement with the United Aleut Nation.


NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council hereby rescinds Resolution 96-19 Joint Powers Agreement with the United Aleut Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the United Aleut Nation is informed by this resolution that it no longer has the authority to represent the Qagan Tayagungin Tribe with any federal, state, or any other agency on any matter from this day forward without the express written consent of the Qagan Tayagungin Tribal Council.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY A DULY CONSTITUTED QUORUM OF THE QAGAN TAYAGUNGIN TRIBAL COUNCIL THIS 8th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1999. VOTE: 5 in favor; 0 opposed; 0 abstained.
