## *Styrofoam*

Lets effectively reduce the waste that goes into our landfill. Styrofoam is made from crude oil and is non-renewable and non compostable.

Styrofoam also breaks up into small pieces and can be ingested by bird life, marine animals, and fish killing them through starvation, The production of Styrofoam is toxic to our environment and studies have shown that chemicals in polystyrene foam are carcinogenic and can leach into food and drink.

Compostable products include:

- Coated and uncoated paper or other natural fiber products
- Plant-based plastic-like products that are clearly labeled as compostable.
